hereafter referred to as Company, being an adult over the age of eighteen (18) years of age, do hereby certify the above-named Company, under the provisions of Subtitle F, Title 10, Government Code Chapter 2274:

- 5. Has ten (10) or more full-time employees;
- Will be paid an amount equal to or greater than \$100,000.00 from City of Sugar Land funds, under the contract to which this verification applies;
- Does not currently have a practice, policy, guidance, or directive that discriminates against a firearm entity or firearm trade association; and
- Will not discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association during the term of the contract for goods or services with the above-named Company, business, or individual with City of Sugar Land.

Pursuant to Section 2274.001, Texas Government Code:

- "Company" means a for-profit organization, association, corporation, partnership, joint venture, limited partnership, limited liability partnership, or limited liability company, including a wholly owned subsidiary, majority-owned subsidiary, parent company, or affiliate of those entities or associations that exists to make a profit. The term does not include a sole proprietorship.
- 2. "Discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association"
 - (A) means, with respect to the entity or association, to:
 - refuse to engage in the trade of any goods or services with the entity or association based solely on its status as a firearm entity or firearm trade association;
 - (ii) refrain from continuing an existing business relationship with the entity or association based solely on its status as a firearm entity or firearm trade association; or
 - (iii) terminate an existing business relationship with the entity or association based solely on its status as a firearm entity or firearm trade association; and
 - (B) does not include:
 - the established policies of a merchant, retail seller, or platform that restrict or prohibit the listing or selling of ammunition, firearms, or firearm accessories; and
 - (ii) a company's refusal to engage in the trade of any goods or services, decision to refrain from continuing an existing business relationship, or decision to terminate an existing business relationship:
 - (aa) to comply with federal, state, or local law, policy, or regulations or a directive by a regulatory agency; or
 - (bb)for any traditional business reason that is specific to the customer or potential customer and not based solely on an entity's or association's status as a firearm entity or firearm trade association.
