

RESOLUTION NO. 22-48

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUGAR LAND, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DOT), OFFICE OF THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY FOR RESEARCH AND TECHNOLOGY (OST-R) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 STRENGTHENING MOBILITY AND REVOLUTIONIZING TRANSPORTATION (SMART) GRANTS, AND DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AS AUTHORIZED GRANT OFFICIAL TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, REJECT, ALTER, OR TERMINATE THE GRANT AND TO EXECUTE ALL GRANT DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sugar Land ("City") finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City to submit an application to the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT), Office of the Assistant Secretary for Research and Technology (OST-R) for the Fiscal Year 2022 Strengthening Mobility and Revolutionizing Transportation (SMART) Grants, to fund projects that are focused on using technology to improve transportation efficiency and safety; NOW, THEREFORE,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SUGAR LAND, TEXAS:**

Section 1. That it adopts the findings and recitals set forth in the preamble to this Resolution.

Section 2. That it authorizes the submission of a grant application to the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT), Office of the Assistant Secretary for Research and Technology (OST-R) for the Fiscal Year 2022 Strengthening Mobility and Revolutionizing Transportation (SMART) Grants.

Section 3. That the City Manager, or his designee, is designated as authorized grant official to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant and to execute all grant documents on behalf of the City of Sugar Land.
