

**AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE CITY OF SUGAR LAND, TEXAS AND
SUGAR CREEK CENTER PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION**

This Agreement (Agreement) is entered into between the City of Sugar Land, Texas (City) and the Sugar Creek Center Property Owners Association (Association).

Background

The Association is a property owners' association created for the Sugar Creek Center community located within the City. By Resolution No. 20-03 the City Council of the City of Sugar Land adopted a Council Policy Regarding Participation With Community-Based Organizations in Capital Improvement Projects Using 4B Corporation Funds (Policy). Under the Policy, in 2022 the Association submitted an application requesting that the Sugar Land 4B Corporation (SL4B) assist with funding entryway signage improvements to be located at the entrances to the Sugar Creek Center Office Park at: (1) US Hwy. 90A and Commerce Green Blvd.; (2) US Hwy. 59 and Commerce Green Blvd.; and (3) US Hwy. 59 and Sugar Creek Center Blvd. The SL4B adopted Resolution No. SL4B-R-23-01 approving funding for the entryway signage improvements. The City and the Association desire to enter into this Agreement to establish the terms of the entryway signage improvements.

Agreement

In consideration of the promises of each, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Definitions.** In this Agreement:

Agreement means this Agreement between the City of Sugar Land, Texas and the Sugar Creek Center Property Owners Association.

Application means the Sugar Land 4B Corporation Joint CIP Program Application 2023 submitted by the Association to the City on or about October 13, 2022.

Association means the Sugar Creek Center Property Owners Association, its successors and assigns.

City means the City of Sugar Land, Texas.

Consent to Encroachment means the Consent to Encroachment granted by the City to the Association, allowing the Improvements to be constructed and maintained within the ROWs, according to the terms thereof, which are attached as Exhibit A.

Improvements mean the entryway signage improvements to be located at the entrances to the Sugar Creek Center Office Park at: (1) US Hwy. 90A and Commerce Green Blvd.; (2) US Hwy. 59 and Commerce Green Blvd.; and (3) US Hwy. 59 and Sugar Creek Center Blvd., which are

located within City right-of-way (ROW), the depiction and specifications of which are shown in the attached Exhibit B, which is incorporated into this Agreement.

ROWS means: (1) that certain tract or parcel of land situated in the George Brown & Charles Belknap League, Abstract No. 15, in Fort Bend County Texas; and being Commerce Green Blvd., a 6.999 acre right of way as created by the plat of SUGAR CREEK CENTER, as recorded under File No. 1175338 of the Fort Bend County Plat Records (the “Commerce Green ROW”); and (2) that certain tract or parcel of land situated in the George Brown & Charles Belknap League, Abstract No. 15, in Fort Bend County Texas; and being Sugar Creek Center Blvd., a 5.505 acre right of way as created by the plat of SUGAR CREEK CENTER, as recorded under File No. 1175338 of the Fort Bend County Plat Records (the “Sugar Creek Center ROW”) (collectively, the Commerce Green ROW and the Sugar Creek Center ROW are the “ROWS”).

2. Effective Date and Term. This Agreement is effective on the latest date of the parties’ signatures and ends on the date the City makes payment to Association as provided in this Agreement.

3. Installation. The Association will own and may install, maintain, and replace the Improvements within the ROWs in compliance with this Agreement, the Consent to Encroachment, the City’s ordinances, and other applicable laws and regulations. The Association will enter into a contract(s) with contractor(s) to construct the Improvements. The Association must obtain any permits and pay any fees required by the City or other governmental entities relating to the installation of the Improvements within the ROWs, including any permits or fees required for working in City right-of-way.

4. Maintenance. After construction and installation, the Association must maintain and keep the Improvements in good condition and repair and in compliance with the Consent to Encroachment, the City’s ordinances, and other laws.

5. City Reimbursement for Improvements. Upon completion of the Improvements, the Association will submit to the City:

- (a) Copies of all required permits obtained for installation of the Improvements;
- (b) Copies of receipts, cleared checks, bank statements, or a combination thereof, showing that all the contractor(s) have been paid a total amount of at least \$211,535.00.
- (c) A letter from the Association President warranting that the Improvements have been completed according the requirements of this Agreement; and
- (d) Photographs of the completed Improvements.

The City will make one payment of \$75,000.00 to the Association within 30 days of the City’s review and approval of the documents and photographs listed above.

6. Consent to Encroachment. This Agreement is not effective until the City and the Association have executed the Consent to Encroachment and the Association has filed it of record

in the Fort Bend County, Texas Official Public Records.

7. Termination.

- (a) If the Association fails to substantially begin work to install the Improvements within 60 days of the effective date of this Agreement, the City's city manager may terminate this Agreement by giving the Association at least 10 days' written notice of termination prior to the date of termination.
- (b) The City may terminate this Agreement as provided in this paragraph if the Association fails to comply with any provision of this Agreement. The City will give the Association notice of the default in writing citing the terms of the Agreement that have been breached and what action the Association must take to cure the default. If the Association fails to cure the default as specified in the notice within 30 days after receiving the notice (or such longer period as may be necessary provided that the Association promptly begins curing the default and diligently continues such efforts to completion), the City's city manager may terminate this Agreement by written notice to the Association, specifying the date of termination.

8. Notices. All notices required under this Agreement must be in writing and may be sent by: (a) delivering the notice in person; (b) depositing the notice in the U. S. Mail, certified or registered, return receipt requested, postage prepaid; (c) by depositing the notice with Federal Express or another nationally recognized courier service for next day delivery; or (d) sending the notice by telefax with confirming copy sent by mail. Notice is deemed effective when received by the Party to be notified. All notices must be sent or delivered to the following addresses or as the City or the Association may hereafter designate by written notice:

9. Binding Agreement. This Agreement is binding on the Association, its successors, assigns and grantees.

10. Law Governing and Venue. This Agreement is governed by the law of the State of Texas and a lawsuit may only be prosecuted on this Contract in a court of competent jurisdiction located in or having jurisdiction in Fort Bend County, Texas.

11. Entire Agreement. This Agreement represents the entire agreement between the City and the Association and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, or contracts, either written or oral. This Agreement may be amended only by written instrument signed by both parties.

12. Severability. If a court finds or rules that any part of this Agreement is invalid or unlawful, the remainder of the Agreement continues to be binding on the parties.

Consent to Encroach

CONSENT TO ENCROACHMENT

The City of Sugar Land, Texas (City) has rights-of-way (ROW) across, over, under, and on the real properties (Property) in Fort Bend County, Texas, described as follows:

That certain tract or parcel of land situated in the George Brown & Charles Belknap League, Abstract No. 15, in Fort Bend County Texas; and being Commerce Green Blvd., a 6.999 acre right of way as created by the plat of SUGAR CREEK CENTER, as recorded under File No. 1175338 of the Fort Bend County Plat Records (the “Commerce Green ROW”); and

That certain tract or parcel of land situated in the George Brown & Charles Belknap League, Abstract No. 15, in Fort Bend County Texas; and being Sugar Creek Center Blvd., a 5.505 acre right of way as created by the plat of SUGAR CREEK CENTER, as recorded under File No. 1175338 of the Fort Bend County Plat Records (the “Sugar Creek Center ROW”)

(collectively, the Commerce Green ROW and the Sugar Creek Center ROW are the “ROWS”).

Sugar Creek Center Property Owners Association (Association) is requesting permission to install entryway signage (Improvements) within: (1) the Commerce Green ROW located at the intersections of Commerce Green Blvd. and US Hwy. 90A and Commerce Green Blvd. and US Hwy. 59; and (2) the Sugar Creek Center ROW located at the intersection of Sugar Creek Center Blvd. and US Hwy. 59, as generally described and shown in Exhibit A (Encroachment Areas).

The Association has requested, and the City has agreed, to give its written consent to the Association maintaining the Improvements within the Encroachment Areas of the ROWs under the conditions of this Consent to Encroachment. The Association’s Improvements (as more fully defined below) and the Encroachment Areas are as shown in Exhibit A, attached to and incorporated herein by reference.

In consideration of the granting of this Consent to Encroachment, the Association agrees as follows:

1. The City’s consent to encroachment is limited to entryway signage that meets the requirements of, and are constructed and maintained in compliance with, the City’s ordinances and regulations, and any permits issued by the City for the entryway signage (Improvements). The Improvements will be located within the Encroachment Areas as described above and generally shown in Exhibit A. The Association will not enlarge, reconstruct, or replace the Improvements without the City’s prior written approval.
2. After construction of the Improvements, the Association must perpetually maintain and keep the Improvements within the ROWs in good condition and repair, including the cost of maintenance, removal or replacement of the Improvements.

3. SUGAR CREEK CENTER PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION WILL INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS THE CITY, ITS OFFICERS, AGENTS, AND EMPLOYEES, FROM AND AGAINST ALL CLAIMS, LOSSES, DAMAGES, CAUSES OF ACTION, SUITS, AND LIABILITY OF EVERY KIND, INCLUDING ALL EXPENSES OF LITIGATION, COURT COSTS, AND ATTORNEY'S FEES, FOR INJURY TO OR DEATH OF ANY PERSON, OR FOR DAMAGE TO ANY PROPERTY, ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONSTRUCTION, REPAIR, MODIFICATION, USE OR EXISTENCE OF THE IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE ROWS.
4. The City may remove or alter the Improvements if it determines that removal or alteration is necessary to properly maintain, repair, replace, relocate, alter its facilities or to make proper use of the ROWs. **SUGAR CREEK CENTER PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION RELEASES THE CITY, ITS OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AND CONTRACTORS, FROM ANY LIABILITY FOR THE REMOVAL, ALTERATION, OR DAMAGE CAUSED TO THE IMPROVEMENTS BY THEIR REMOVAL OR ALTERATION, OR BY THE PRESENCE OR MALFUNCTIONING OF THE CITY'S ROWS, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE CITY'S NEGLIGENCE MAY CAUSE OR CONTRIBUTE TO SUCH LOSS OR DAMAGE.**
5. The Association must comply with the federal, state and City ordinances and regulations.
6. This Consent to Encroachment shall be binding on the Association's successors, assigns and grantees.
7. Nothing herein shall be construed to be waiver of any restrictions or ordinance, nor shall it be construed to be a waiver of any permits or approval of any third parties, governmental or otherwise, for the construction of structures except as herein provided.
9. The Association agrees to pay to the City the amount of any costs the City incurs in (i) maintaining or repairing any public improvements as a result of the encroachments; and (ii) removing, altering or relocating the Improvements as allowed by this Consent to Encroachment. The Association will pay to the City the costs within 30 days of the date the City sends a written request for payment of the costs, which will specifically describe the costs incurred as to labor, equipment, and other expenses.
9. This Consent to Encroachment shall not be effective until the Association provides for an executed copy thereof to be recorded in the Real Property Records of Fort Bend County. After recordation, the Association shall provide a copy of the recorded instrument to the City.





GENERAL NOTES ABOUT BID SUBMITTAL

Refer to Project Manual

GENERAL NOTES FOR FABRICATION AND INSTALLATION OF THIS PROJECT

- Do not scale the drawings. All sign copy should be considered to be representative and is subject to change. Refer to final message schedule for final copy on all signs.
- The Contract Documents are complementary, and what is required by one shall be as binding as if required by all. The Graphics Contractor shall coordinate all required portions of work in contract scope.
- The Graphics Contractor shall conform to these drawings and specifications and submit to the Graphic Designer samples for all finishes included in their scope of work before commencement of such work.
- For the purpose of bidding process, proprietary names identifying items of work are used solely to describe the standard of the product or the color of the finish, unless the items of work are explicitly noted as not having an equal. Graphics Contractor shall secure approval of any substitutions from the Graphic Designer. Any items approved for substitution should be submitted to the Graphic Designer for final approval.
- All dimensions are to the exterior face of the finished material unless otherwise noted. All elevations are noted from finished floor elevations.
- All dimensions of existing work and all dimensions required for work that is connected with work in place shall be verified by the Graphics Contractor. In addition, the Graphics Contractor shall verify all finishes and notify the Graphic Designer of any discrepancies before performing any work.
- The Graphics Contractor shall notify the Graphic Designer of any discrepancies in the fabrication documents immediately and shall not proceed or allow sub-fabricators to work in those areas until said discrepancies are resolved.
- When changes are required, for any reason, notify the Graphic Designer before performing any work. Changes which alter the contract documents must have the approval of the Graphic Designer and Architect before commencement of such work. Changes which modify the contract amount must have the approval of the Graphic Designer and Owner before commencement of such work.
- All graphics and colors provided must conform to scale, specifications, and PMS numbers where provided.

10. All work shall be done in accordance with all applicable codes and to the highest standards of trade practice. Refer to Project Manual.

11. Prior to commencing any work, the Graphics Contractor who is awarded all or part of fabrication and/or installation shall review with the Owner, Architect and the Graphic Designer, the phasing of their work and secure approval of all parties. Submit to the Architect and the Graphic Designer a master schedule of the awarded work one (1) week after the contract signing.

12. All interior finish and trim materials are to meet Class III flame spread ratings of 76 to 200, as per applicable code.

13. Graphics Contractor is responsible for obtaining and paying for all applicable permits and certificates required of their work.

14. The Graphics Contractor shall warrant that all merchandise is free of defects in material or workmanship and shall provide Owner with a warranty to replace or repair any merchandise that fails to conform to above for a period of no less than one (1) year from date of final acceptance.

15. The Graphics Contractor shall coordinate all blocking for required signage with the General Contractor. The Graphics Contractor shall provide and install such blocking as required unless previously provided by General Contractor.

16. The Graphics Contractor shall patch and repair all existing surfaces as required prior to applying new finishes. All openings, voids, or unfinished surfaces created by removal or alteration of existing work, shall be closed or patched and finished as necessary to match existing continuous surfaces or new finishes required.

17. All hangers, channels, rods and other misc. support steel shall be installed by the Graphics Contractor as necessary for the support of suspended equipment (signage) and shall be fastened to the existing structure in such a manner as to not compromise its existing structural integrity or fire rating.

18. The Graphics Contractor shall keep the site work area(s) clear of unnecessary debris; and shall keep all work area(s) secured when unattended for the duration of the installation period.

19. The Graphics Contractor shall clean the site of all unnecessary debris and clean all glass, chrome, and any other items before vacating the site and final Owner sign-off.

20. The Graphics Contractor will be required to have all structural elements and attachments of exterior signs stamped by an engineer licensed within the State of the completed work. The Graphics Contractor is to coordinate with the General Contractor, Structural Engineer on Project and Graphic Designer to meet requirements and standard and approved methods of fabrication.

- All signage design and construction are to comply with the interpretation of the ADAAG and with applicable State and Municipal Building and Fire Codes. The Graphics Contractor is responsible for the verification of the ADAAG compliance and advising the Graphic Designer and Owner of any conflicts identified.
- The Graphics Contractor is responsible for removal of all existing signage and coordinating with Owner on wall repair at all existing signage locations.

- All Artwork and Drawings are not to be reproduced or circulated for use outside the scope of this contract without written consent of the Owner. Failure to do so will result in legal action to the fullest extent of the law.





SPECIFICATIONS/NOTES

- Graphics Contractor is to coordinate all work with the General Contractor.
- Graphics Contractor is required to submit three (3) 4" x 4" x 1/8" thick acrylic samples of each of the specified colors/materials on primer/material base indicated per details to the Graphic Designer for review and approval. Failure to comply with sample submission may cause rejection and/or refabrication of signage.
- If a color or material is to match a logo element or material specified by others, Graphics Contractor is to match specs exactly.
- Standard cleaning, prefushing and application of filler or primer required.
- Alternate versions, such as metallic paint or reflective vinyl, may exist in some applications. Refer to details.
- Provide two (2) layers of protective matte clear coat on all visible surfaces. Provide control sample for approval.
- Finish spray paint surfaces with protective UV Protective inhibitors on all exposed faces of exterior painted surfaces.
- Specialty finish requires oversized samples for Designer/Owner approval.
- Milky white diffuser sheets may be used.
