A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUGAR LAND, TEXAS, ACCEPTING THE STATE OF TEXAS, OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 BULLET-RESISTANT SHIELD GRANT PROGRAM; AND DESIGNATING THE DEPUTY CITY MANAGER AS AUTHORIZED GRANT OFFICIAL TO EXECUTE ALL GRANT DOCUMENTS AND IMPLEMENT THE GRANT.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sugar Land ("City") finds it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City to accept the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division, for Fiscal Year 2023 Bullet-Resistant Shield Grant Program ("Grant"), for the purchase of bullet-resistant shields to protect the lives of law enforcement officers; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUGAR LAND, TEXAS:

- **Section 1.** That it adopts the findings and recitals set forth in the preamble to this Resolution.
- **Section 2.** That the City accepts the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division, for Fiscal Year 2023 Bullet-Resistant Shield Grant Program ("Grant"), attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference Exhibit A.
- **Section 3.** That the Deputy City Manager is designated as authorized grant official to execute all Grant documents on behalf of the City of Sugar Land and implement the Grant.
 - **Section 4.** That the City agrees to provide any matching funds as required by the Grant.
- **Section 5.** That in the event of loss or misuse of any Grant funds awarded to the City, the City assures that the awarded Grant funds will be returned to the State of Texas Office of the Governor in full.
