Introduction

- SiFi is proposing the development of an open access fiber-optic network infrastructure through City Right-of-Ways
- The non-exclusive open access network will be used by Internet Service Providers (ISP)s to deliver broadband internet access
- Full 100% fiber coverage across the entire City, including underserviced areas
- Fully funded through private investment with no cost to the City
- Future use of the fiber-optic infrastructure by the City


Development Agreement

- 30 year agreement with 10 year extensions
- The larger of a quarterly payment (\$10,000) or a per connection fee (\$2.99) paid to City
- \$500,000 escrow account for damage and restoration
- 12-24 Months of construction planning
- 48 Months to complete full build out
- Construction through micro trenching and directional boring
 - Reduced impacts to parkways with minimized footprint
- Permits required for each stage of the build-out following City construction standards including stop work provisions
- Two 1000 sq ft sheds on City Right of Ways or City property


