## Case Overview

- Existing vacant building at the front of The Park at Sugar Creek shopping center.
- 9750 sq. ft. and proposed 3566 sq. ft. outdoor area screened with 8' opaque fence
- Additional landscaping placed around exterior of fence
- No nearby residential property
- No unsupervised animals outdoors
- CUP is not in conflict with Land Use Plan as part of a Neighborhood Activity Center


## Public Hearing Recap

- P\&Z held public hearing on Jan 26 - no speakers
- Concerns for fencing, maximum number of animals, waste disposal, and noise.
- Size recommendation for daycare is $12 \mathrm{ft}^{2}$ and $18 \mathrm{ft}^{2}$ for small and large dogs respectively.
- The USDA has recommended minimum sizes for overnight boarding based on the size of the dog which K9 exceeds with their room sizes.
- Waste, fencing, and staffing is all in alignment or exceeding the quality provided by the city-operated animal shelter


## Residential Proximity

- 200ft to nearest home from facility
- 400ft to nearest home from US 59
- Based on sound properties, the loudest dogs cannot be heard over the quietest traffic at these distances.
