- Rainfalls in excess of 30"+ over a week






Background









Update - Bridges

- Identified 3 weeks after Harvey







Update - Bridges

- Wood Street Bridge Repairs (South)
- Staff initiated a RFQ
- Design Contract with Aguirre and Fields for \$5,000
- Construction contract to Cedros Paving for \$48,000




Update - Bridges

- Wood Street Bridge Repairs (North)
- No Surface Damage
- Received FEMA Approval
- Staff will initiated a RFQ
- Anticipate Similar Design as South Approach
- Estimated Construction Cost \$48,000




- Damages Identified

 - Joint Sealing Multiple Locations




- City incorporated the FEMA Information into an Invitation To Bid.
- Published on January 18 and 25, 2018
- Bids Opened on February 1, 2018

Bidder	Bid
HTI Construction	\$93,559.00
Cedros Paving Services	\$114,239.00
ISI	\$129,770.00
Team Work	\$164,390.00
Wade Construction	\$188,290.00



- HTI Construction Inc. was the apparent low bidder at \$93,559.
- HTI Construction Inc. has worked with the City of Angleton in the past and received positive references.
- Construction to begin in March and be completed by June.



Budget Amendment

- Since these expenditures were not budgeted, a budget amendment is required to allocate funding to pay for these contracts.
- Budget Amendment Amount

Irrigation Assessment/Repairs	\$10,350
Bridge Design/Repairs	\$101,000
Street Repairs	\$93,559
Total	\$204.909



Reimbursement

Reimbursement from FEMA


- Typical: 75% reimbursement

- Harvey: 90% reimbursement



Recommendation

 Staff recommends that the City Council authorize a construction contract between the City of Sugar Land and HTI Construction, Inc. for Harvey related damage repairs in the amount of \$93,559.00, and authorize a budget amendment in the amount of \$204,909.
