

RESOLUTION NO. 23-45

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUGAR LAND, TEXAS, APPOINTING A CITIZEN'S TASK FORCE TO CONDUCT A FIVE-YEAR REVIEW OF CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE IV, CODE OF ETHICAL CONDUCT AND PROVIDE A REPORT TO CITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, on December 20, 2022, City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2289 amending the Code of Ethical Conduct by adding a new section 2-74 requiring a five-year review of the Code of Ethical Conduct; and

WHEREAS, the last review of the Code of Ethical Conduct occurred in 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council believe it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Sugar Land to appoint a citizens task force, comprised of Sugar Land residents, to conduct a comprehensive five-year review the current Code of Ethical Conduct and provide a written report to City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SUGAR LAND, TEXAS:**

Section 1. That the current Independent Ethics Review Board members and alternates are appointed to serve as the Ethics Task Force.

Section 2. That the Ethics Task Force is charged with conducting a comprehensive review of the current Code of Ethical Conduct to determine if revisions should be made to conform with state law and to ensure that the ethical values set forth in the Code continue to reflect the values, principles and standards expected by the residents of the city.

Section 3. That the City Manager will designate a primary staff liaison and provide other forms of appropriate administrative support to the Ethics Task Force on behalf of City Council.
