Re: Funding Award for the City of Sugar Land

Dear Mr. Goodrum:

H-GAC staff reviewed and recommended funding the City of Sugar Land's Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Commuter and Transit Pilot Project application to support new microtransit service.

The H-GAC Board of Directors awarded the City of Sugar Land federal funding for the first year of service on February 20, 2024. Staff will support the project's first year with funding provided through an Advanced Funding Agreement (AFA) 0912-00-476 with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT).

The federal funding for the first year of this service shall not exceed \$1,194,176.00. The local match required is \$298,544.00, for a total funding amount of \$1,492,720.00. Funding to support the pilot may be renewable for up to two additional years, pending mutual agreement between H-GAC and the City of Sugar Land.
