Company Background

- Accredo Packaging, Inc. (API)
 - API Group of companies was founded in 1986 and has over 1,000 employees globally
 - They manufacture and supply sustainable high added value flexible packaging predominantly for the pre-packaged foods and consumer products markets in North America.
 - The proposed Phase III project is to increase production capabilities due to new customers and additional orders from their largest customer.
 - Company has requested tax abatement in order to move forward; abatement would meet policy guidelines



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


Minimum Qualifications

- Required to be created prior to entering into a tax abatement
- Reinvestment Zone 2018-01 meets state criteria due to retention and expansion of primary employment that contributes to economic development in Sugar Land

Reinvestment Zone 2018-01

- Property is 17.2163 acres
- Located directly south of 12682
 Cardinal Meadow Drive, adjacent to Accredo's existing facilities
