Background

- FBISD began construction in fall of 2017 ullet
- In response to Mr. Reginald Moore's concerns, FBISD ulletengaged Goshawk Environmental Consulting, Inc.
- On February 17th, historical grave was discovered \bullet
- Goshawk began further investigations under the direction of ulletthe Texas Historical Commission (THC)
- Site boundaries were determined, believed to contain 94 grave shafts

- Discussions between FBISD and City of Sugar Land staff
 - Identify most appropriate and dignified course of action
 - Imperial Prison Farm Cemetery obtained by the City
 - City owned and maintained

Memorandum of Understanding

- Memorandum of Understanding between City of Sugar Land and **FBISD**
 - High level agreement that outlines responsibilities
- Allows for a formal Interlocal Agreement •
 - Include details and anticipated cost estimates associated with relocation and interment

Memorandum of Understanding

- Fort Bend Independent School District ullet
 - Conduct exhumation ongoing
 - Approval of Interlocal Agreement
 - Submit a petition to the court for removal and reburial
 - Costs associated with: storage, new burial vessels, transportation, interment, and security
 - Procurement and placement of temporary markers for each grave

Memorandum of Understanding

- City of Sugar Land ullet
 - Approval of Interlocal Agreement
 - Costs associated with: layout design and location, maintenance, future park development (walking paths, interpretive historical information, and parking)
 - Procurement and placement of permanent markers for each grave

- Begin drafting Interlocal Agreement with FBISD
- Complete exhumation
- FBISD file a petition with the court
