- Outstanding CIP Items
 - Accelerate Settlers Park/Mesquite North
 - Feasible to move up
 - No financial need to delay construction of Animal Shelter



- Outstanding CIP Items
 - Accelerate Commonwealth/Elkins
 - Not Feasible
 - Requires extensive coordination with the LID



- Outstanding CIP Items
 - Add License Plate Recognition Cameras (LPR's)
 - Not Feasible at this time
 - Add to the unfunded list
 - Develop a plan for future consideration



- Outstanding CIP Items
 - Add Public Safety Training Facility
 - Not Feasible at this time
 - Add to the unfunded list
 - Develop a plan for future consideration



- Outstanding General Fund Items
 - Review Sales Tax to update projections for FY19
 - Staff recommends making the adjustment
 - Retaining the flat nominal tax rate to fund base budget
 - Revised YTD through July sales tax data
 - Offsets \$300,000 in property tax revenue



- Continue with General Fund Budget as filed, recognizing additional recurring revenue from revised sales tax projections
- Staff will have an additional opportunity to review with Council at the August 21st meeting:
 - Corporate Communications plan
 - State of the City
 - Sugar Land Calendar
 - Sugar Land Today
