



What is the Charter?

- Founding document of the City
- Sets out basic structure and processes of the City





What is the Charter Commission's role and why is it important?

- The Charter guides City Council's and key staff's duties and responsibilities, so it needs to be kept up-to-date
- The Commission reviews the Charter to determine if revisions should be proposed
- If the Commission deems revisions necessary, make recommendation to City Council for future placement on a ballot
