## August, 2018 - Council budget workshop


- Provided master plan updates (overall layouts)

- Upcoming: prop foundation, water lines & gun range upgrades



#### **Site Access**


- Provide a paved access road along the west side of the airport to facilitate future airport development

- Unit 3 Scheduled to be funded in FY20, potential to add back in by change order
