

Project Scope

- > Rehab of lift station components:
 - > Valve vault improvement
 - > New pumps
 - > Riser and header piping
 - > Electrical improvements
 - > Wet well recoating
 - > SCADA Connectivity
 - > Miscellaneous improvements

Contractor Selection

- > Bid package:
 - Three lift stations in base bid: First Colony Commons (No 38), Sartartia (NO 403) and, Campbell Elementary (No 509)
 - > One lift station in add alternate: Trudeau (No 45)
- Bid advertised on September 25 and October 2, 2019
- Five (5) bids received/opened on October 17, 2019
