#### **Project Background**

- > The Brazos River Park Road Extension
  - Original concept envisioned a crushed concrete trail for pedestrian / bicycle access & a mid-lake
- ➤ TXDOT's permanent closing of the US 59 return under the Brazos River bridge reduced vehicle access to the Brazos River Park and the Crown Festival Park
- Project scope revised to improve vehicular, pedestrian, and bicycle daily access and for special events

### **Project Scope**

- Base bid
  - Two-lane, one mile long concrete road with pavement markings
  - Four (4) concrete box culverts at the low water crossing over LID # 17 outfall channel
  - 8-ft wide pedestrian concrete trail and landscaping
- > Alternate A Irrigation system
- > Alternate B Illumination and lighting

#### **Contractor Selection**

- Design completed in May 2020
- Received No adverse impact letter from LID # 17
- No USACE permit required (less than 0.1 Ac and less than 200 feet of impact)
- Bids were advertised on May 27 and June 3, 2020
- Bids were opened June 18, 2020
- Seven (7) bids were received
