

RESOLUTION NO. 21-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUGAR LAND, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE REBUILDING AMERICAN INFRASTRUCTURE WITH SUSTAINABILITY AND EQUITY (RAISE DISCRETIONARY GRANT PROGRAM) AND APPOINTING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, AS AUTHORIZED GRANT OFFICIAL TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, OR DECLINE THE GRANT AND TO EXECUTE ALL GRANT DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sugar Land ("City") finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City to submit an application to the U.S. Department of Transportation for the 2021 RAISE Grant ("Grant") program, for funds for the Intelligent Transportation System Railroad Monitoring project study and design; NOW, THEREFORE:

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SUGAR LAND, TEXAS:**

Section 1. That it adopts the findings and recitations set forth in the preamble to this Resolution.

Section 2. That it authorizes the submission of a grant application to the U.S. Department of Transportation for the 2021 RAISE Grant ("Grant") for funds for the Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) Railroad monitoring project study and design including an upgrade and expansion to the current railroad monitoring system to detect and provide effective notifications for blocked rail crossings on US 90A.

Section 3. That the City Manager, or his designee, is appointed as the authorized grant official to apply for, accept, or decline the Grant and to execute all Grant documents on behalf of the City of Sugar Land.
