### BACKGROUND

- 2009 a Preliminary Engineering Report (PER) completed with recommendation to widen roadway due to capacity issues
- 2012 UPRR began discussions of a double track system along US 90A corridor
- > 2014 Council approved the design contract for the Dairy Ashford Widening Project ST1405
- > 2014 city coordinated with UPRR regarding the Dairy Ashford improvements
- 2015 UPRR extended the existing railroad line which included the double track




#### BACKGROUND

- 2016 staff submitted 90% plans to UPRR for review/approval
- 2016 project placed on hold until comments received from UPRR
- November 2017 received plan approval, draft language and estimates for the agreement from UPRR
- December 2017 staff began coordinating with consultant to finalize plans and permits
- January 2018 received final agreement from UPRR









### **CITY OBLIGATIONS**

- Construct, maintain and repair the roadway over and across the tracks
- > Install the conduit for the preemption
- Fund the UPRR plan review and approval fees \$17,400
- Fund all UPRR materials and labor for the surface and signal work - \$639,952
- Contractor to submit Right-of-Entry agreement prior to commencing work in UPRR rights-of-way



# **UPRR OBLIGATIONS**

- Relocate existing cabin
- Relocate existing gate arms and install new arms
- Remove existing crossing surface
- Extend existing crossing surface on the east side and install new surface, including ties and rail on the west side



# FUNDING/SCHEDULE

- > Funding available in CIP No. ST1405 \$6.4 MIL
- October 2015 City Council approved FBC Interlocal Agreement (ILA)
  - ✓ 2007 Mobility Bonds \$830K
- Bid in April 2018
- > Award in May 2018



#### RECOMMENDATION

Approve and authorize the execution of the At-Grade Crossing Agreement with UPRR in the amount of \$657,352 for the Dairy Ashford Widening Project, CIP No. ST1405.
