

RESOLUTION NO. 17-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUGAR LAND, TEXAS, APPROVING SUBMISSION OF A COMPREHENSIVE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, A DIVISION OF THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sugar Land ("City") finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City to submit a Comprehensive Hazard Mitigation Grant Application to the Texas Division of Emergency Management, a division of the Texas Department of Public Safety, for the Flood Early Warning System ("FEWS") improvements project to upgrade 13 existing precipitation and stream gauges to the latest Alert 2 technology and to expand the FEWS coverage with 10 new gauges; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City agrees to provide all applicable matching funds as required by the grant application; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City designates the City Manager as the City's authorized official; NOW THEREFORE,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SUGAR LAND:**

Section 1. That it adopts the findings and recitals set forth in the preamble to this Resolution.

Section 2. That it approves the submission of the Comprehensive Hazard Mitigation Grant Application to the Texas Division of Emergency Management for the Flood Early Warning System ("FEWS") improvement project to upgrade 13 existing precipitation and stream gauges to the latest Alert 2 technology and to expand the FEWS coverage with 10 new gauges.

Section 3. That the authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the City of Sugar Land.
