PROJECT BACKGROUND

- COSL's Flood Early Warning System installed between 2004 and 2006
- The System has 16 gauge stations located in channels, bayous and detention basis measuring rainfalls & stream stages
- The Flood Alert System (Alert 1) integrates radar, rain gauges, bayou stage data and hydrologic modeling to provides early waring on flooding

PROJECT BACKGROUND (CONT.)

- Alert 1 hardware and software technology is outdated
- System loses up to 30 to 45 % of the data during storms.
- It's necessary to update the existing system to Alert 2 and to install new gauges to increase coverage especially in the ETJ areas to be annexed in end of 2017

- The Grant will support the City's Flood Early Warning System **Improvement Project**

- Improving precipitation and stream gauge coverage of the **City and the annexation areas**
