




IWRP Definition and Process

- Formal way to rank water supply alternative
- Outputs can include policy recommendations, management strategies, and capital projects
- Incorporates the economics, reliability, equity, environment, & social aspects of water resource management
- Identify specific objectives
- Short term and long term programs
- Creates community support through consensus building

- December 20- Resolution 16-46
- February 7, 2017- Water Supply Reliability Study Contract
- March 21- Citizen Task Force formed

- Review and provide feedback of the questions to be answered


