
Background

- City Council adopted Financial Management Policy Statements provide guidance on user fees
- New user fees recommended to recover costs based on level of public benefit
- Annual CPI adjustment to user fees based on Houston MSA for February

 - January 2018




New Fees


- FY18 proposed budget includes two types of new fees
 - Expedited Temporary Food Permit \$25.00
 - Fee for late application submission for temporary food permit
 - Late Rental License Permit \$30.00
 - Fee for late submission of annual rental licenses




- Parkland fees in lieu of dedication
 - Addition to Code of Ordinance section 2-136
 - Previously existed in Development Code but not in fee section



- Building permits
 - Adjust code of ordinance language to comply with HB 3329, which prevents a City from charging for an electrical permit
 - Building permits which would cover inspections would remain in line with previous electrical permits
 - Building permits would also be revised to include plumbing and mechanical services, with fees in line with pervious permits for those activities




- Plan Check Fees
 - Adjusts language to better correspond to the minimum fee amount already within the ordinance
- ETJ fire protection fee: full cost of service
 - \$17.09 to \$17.68 per fire service connection, per month



Special Events Application Fees

- Adjusted cost recovery calculation structure
 - Creates a more efficient and transparent cost recovery mechanism
 - Rates stated by positions most likely involved
 - Based on 75th percentile of over-time rates and benefits for each non-exempt position title
 - Includes a catch-all for positions not noted



Solid Waste

- Residential Solid Waste & Recycling
 - Adjusted 2.5% per contract
 - Increases from \$18.00 to \$18.45 per month
- Commercial Solid Waste
 - Adjusted All Rates 2.5% per contract



Water/Wastewater Utilities

- No changes to GRP, surface water rates, or water and wastewater rates
 - Stable rates based on Rate Model
 - 2011 Last Water/WW increase



CPI Adjustment

- Fees were evaluated to determine the need for an increase relative to the CPI
- Certain fees adjusted for CPI
 - February 2017 CPI of 2.10%
