- August 19, 2014 City Council Approved Resolution 14-32
- Created a Public Improvement District to finance improvements
  - 54.49 Acre Single Family Development
  - 130 homes anticipated
  - Similar to a MUD but limited

# **Background**

- Once the certified value in the PID exceeds \$31M, the City will reimburse the developer up to \$2 M for infrastructure + interest
- 2017 Value = \$28.13M
- Annual Assessments to properties will be used to pay debt service on the reimbursement

## **Proposed Assessment**

- Based on estimated reimbursement
- 2017 Assessment \$1,005 per lot
- Due whether lot is built on or not
- Excludes landscape reserves and rights of way
- Assessment estimated to decline as City contributes 50% of property taxes from the PID area to help repay the reimbursement

#### **Assessment**

- Included on Property Tax statements sent from Fort Bend County Tax Office
- Collected by Tax Office and remitted to the City
- Public Hearing Held August 22<sup>nd</sup>
- Adopt Assessment in conjunction with Annual Budget Approval

### **Staff Recommendation**

- Approve Ordinance No. 2112
  - Establish assessment of \$1,005 per lot for 2017 for Enclave at River Park PID
  - Establish Service & Assessment Plan for 2018-22
