# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUGAR LAND, TEXAS, EXPRESSING INTENT TO FINANCE EXPENDITURES TO BE INCURRED

# THE STATE OF TEXAS § CITY OF SUGAR LAND §

WHEREAS, the City of Sugar Land, Texas (the "City"), is a home rule city of the State of Texas, authorized to finance its activities by issuing obligations pursuant to the Texas Government Code and Texas Local Government Code, which may include obligations the interest on which is excludable from gross income for federal income tax purposes ("Tax-Exempt Bonds"), pursuant to Section 103 of the Internal Revenue of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), or both; and

WHEREAS, the City has made, within the last 60 days, and will continue to make payments with respect to the acquisition of the projects listed on Exhibit A attached hereto (the "Financed Facilities and Improvements"); and

WHEREAS, the City reasonably expects to issue Tax-Exempt Bonds to reimburse itself for the costs associated with the Financed Facilities and Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to reimburse itself for the costs associated with the Financed Facilities and Improvements from the proceeds of Tax-Exempt Bonds to be issued subsequent to the date hereof; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City hereby declares its intent to reimburse itself for all costs paid within the last 60 days and that will be paid subsequent to the date hereof in connection with the acquisition of the Financed Facilities and Improvements from the proceeds of Tax-Exempt Bonds to be issued subsequent to the date hereof.

<u>Section 2.</u> The City reasonably expects that the maximum principal amount of Tax-Exempt Bonds issued by the City to finance costs associated with the Financed Facilities and Improvements listed on Exhibit A and other improvements attached hereto will not exceed \$12,000,000.

Section 3. This Resolution will be kept in the books and records maintained by the City with respect to the Tax-Exempt Bonds.
