PROJECT BACKGROUND

- Built in mid 1960s
- Last plaster/renovation in 2005
- Size:
 - 25m long
 - 6 lanes
 - 3.5'-12' deep
- Restroom building
- Lifeguard office
- Pool Attendance: 6,000 per year



WHY RENOVATION IS NEEDED



- Missing depth deck markers
- Plaster is about 13 years old
- Worn deck coating and expansion joints
- Rusting and degrading trench drain

WHY RENOVATION IS NEEDED



- Worn deck coating
- Rusting and degrading concrete
- Broken strainer hatches


WHY RENOVATION IS NEEDED



- Filter media is due for replacement




VENDOR RECOMMENDED

- **Progressive Commercial Aquatics, Inc.**
 - **BuyBoard**
 - **Scope of Work**
 - **Chip out the old pool plaster and re-plaster with seven-year warranty**
 - **Replace cool deck coating – 3300 SF**
 - **Replace deck trench drain on north side: 100 LF**
 - **Replace filter media**
